The foundation from day one of this ministry is our *Takin' it to the Streets* program.

Most cities in our area will not allow us to meet at specific places for meal distribution, so we take sack lunches directly out to the streets.

We drive around with keen eyes, looking for the homeless. We find them digging in dumpsters, sleeping under benches and often freezing cold. We also give out beanies, gloves and toiletries. If we have clothing, sleeping bags and blankets, we take those as well.

The need is great. With many thanks to our donors, we were able to feed over 1,000 needy folks in 2016!

Years ago, while out on the streets feeding the homeless, we ran into many people who had a roof over their heads but ran out of money before the month was over. We began to bring them groceries, diapers and other basic provi-

sions to help them make it through. A hand up, not out.

They have jobs, they are working! Often all it takes is one of their kids getting sick or their car breaking down and they miss a few days of work....and whammo, they are in dire straits.

We help them by providing gift cards for groceries (so they can buy what they like to eat,) and gift cards for gas for their cars. If
